General

Make sure that washbasins and furniture are dry after use. This will significantly simplify cleaning, and counteract any moisture damage. Make sure that the furniture is not installed in the wet zone, exposed to water spray from shower or in direct contact with eg wet shower curtain.

Always read the operating instructions and product declaration of cleaning products before using them.

Wash fluid containing abrasives or acids should be avoided.

Never let water from the shower sprinkle on the furniture. Never use abrasive shampoo with abrasive,

furniture polish, ammonia or similar as these can break down the paint or scratch the surface. Acetone, thinner or other strong solvents sprayed on the surface should be wiped immediately away not to put marks. Be careful with the use of cleaning tools with sharp edges, as it can cause scratches in the surface.

Sink and bathtub:

Can withstand:

Washbasins and bathtubs withstand wash fluids and other liquids, normally found in the bathroom.

Cannot withstand:

Abrasive powder with abrasive, acid, chlorine, ammonia, wastewater containing caustic soda.

Cleaning:

It is recommended "Clean & Shine" - a concentrated and effective wax shampoo that cleans and provides the washbasin a protective and shiny surface.

Cleaning Instructions:

Use a clean, slightly damp cloth or a sponge with a little "Clean & Shine" and rub the entire sink and bathtub surface. Rinse off with clean water and wipe dry with a clean cloth. The sink and bathtub is now good as new. For both matte and shiny surfaces apply that they can be cleaned with regular abrasive cleaners. Using a wax-resistant surface on both the washbasin and the furniture is easily obtained from a car wax shampoo.
